NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING OF THE HIGHLAND PARK TOWN COUNCIL TO BE HELD ON FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2020, AT 8:00 A.M. IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK TEXAS, 4700 DREXEL DRIVE, HIGHLAND PARK, TEXAS 75205. UNDER SECTION 551.045 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, AN EMERGENCY MEETING IS NECESSARY BECAUSE AN URGENT PUBLIC NECESSITY EXISTS DUE TO A REASONABLY UNFORESEEABLE SITUATION INVOLVING POSSIBLE CIVIL DISTURBANCES AND RIOTING IN TOWN LIMITS.

The Mayor may establish time limits for public comment and may disconnect a call if harassing or other inappropriate comments are made. Persons may only comment once per agenda item.
