Open Invitation for Public Hearing of Re-Accreditation for Highland Park Department of Public Safety

April 5th, 2013 (Highland Park, Texas) On Monday April 15th, 2013 The Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., (CALEA) will conduct a public hearing to discuss the Highland Park Department of Public Safety's nomination for re-accreditation. The purpose of this public hearing is to support the goals of CALEA and improve the delivery of public safety services, primarily by maintaining a body of standards, developed by public safety practitioners which cover a wide range of up-to-date public safety initiatives. CALEA established the standards and administers an accreditation process that recognizes agencies with professional excellence.
