### **Highland Park DPS Looking for Suspect Responsible for Recent Burglaries**

**November 25, 2014 (Highland Park, Texas)** — Highland Park Department of Public Safety officers have recently arrested three suspects in connection with vehicle burglary offenses in Highland Park. One suspect was arrested on November 13, 2014, and two, separate suspects were arrested on November 21, 2014. Two of the three suspects were apprehended secondary to specialized patrol operations. While investigators have been able to clear some of the vehicle burglaries and return stolen property to the victims, not all of the offenses were connected to these suspects. Investigators with Highland Park DPS are asking for the public's assistance in identifying another individual connected to vehicle burglaries in the Highland Park area.

An unidentified suspect has been captured on surveillance video using stolen credit cards at several Wal-Mart stores in Dallas County. These stolen credit cards were taken out of vehicles located in Highland Park, and the credit cards were used within a short time span of the original offense. Due to the overnight hours when the vehicles were burglarized, victims were unaware their credit cards were being used. By the time the victim reported their credit cards stolen, the suspect had already made several purchases on the cards. The most popular purchases were gift cards.
