Highland Park DPS to Participate in Annual, “Click It or Ticket” Campaign

May 22, 2015 (Highland Park, Texas) – Highland Park Department of Public Safety (HPDPS) is participating in the Texas Department of Transportation’s 14th annual "Click It or Ticket" campaign, a statewide time period of increased seat belt enforcement from May 18th to May 31st, 2015. The annual “Click It or Ticket” campaign aims to increase awareness of motorist safety when combined with seatbelt use for both drivers and passengers. Motorists who fail to buckle up in compliance with state seat belt laws may face fines and court fees of up to \$200.00. In 2014 alone, there were 2,587 reportable motor vehicle crashes in Texas in which unrestrained vehicle occupants sustained fatal or serious injuries (TxDOT). Texas law requires the driver and all passengers in a vehicle to be secured by a seat belt.
