UPDATE: Partial Roof Collapse at Three Story, Multi-Family Structure

June 12, 2015 (Highland Park, Texas) – Structural Engineers from two independent agencies have completed their evaluation of the roof collapse at the townhomes located in the 4200 block of Lomo Alto Drive:

- The roof collapse, an estimated 34ft by 20ft, was isolated to the area above three townhomes in the northwest corner of the building and did not extend to other units or attic space.
- Due to the structural damage to the floors and ceilings beneath the roof collapse, three townhomes remain uninhabitable.
- Uninvolved townhomes within the building have been cleared for owner re-entry.
- It is unknown at this time what contributed to the sudden roof collapse.
