Roadway Closure, Eastbound 4200 Mockingbird Lane

April 14, 2016 (Highland Park, Texas) – During overnight hours, Atmos Energy repaired one section of the gas line in the 4200 block of Mockingbird Lane that contained a small leak; however, a complete inspection of the gas line must be completed before the eastbound lane will be reopened. The eastbound lane of 4200 Mockingbird Lane will remain closed while Atmos Energy further inspects the gas line. The westbound lane of 4200 Mockingbird Lane will remain open at this time.

- If no other gas leaks are detected by Atmos Energy, the eastbound lane of 4200 Mockingbird Lane may reopen as soon 8:00 p.m. tonight
- The detection of an additional gas leak will require the eastbound lane of 4200 Mockingbird Lane to remain closed until all repair work is completed

The 4200 block of Mockingbird Lane is bordered by Preston Road to the east, and Douglas Avenue to the west. Motorists who commonly use this section of Mockingbird Lane eastbound are encouraged to plan ahead and use an alternate route.

Residents and businesses near the 4200 block of Mockingbird Lane should call 9-1-1 immediately and leave the area should they detect a strong odor of natural gas. In addition to calling 9-1-1, an individual may contact Atmos Energy directly by using their 24-hour emergency number: 1-866-322-8667.
