Roadway Project to Begin Monday: 4400 – 4900 Preston Road

April 22, 2016 (Highland Park, Texas) – Beginning Monday morning, April 25, 2016, the Town’s contractor, RBR Infrastructure, will begin Phase I of the rehabilitation project for Preston Road. Phase I of the rehabilitation project includes the 4400 – 4900 blocks of Preston Road, the area of Preston Road which is bordered by Armstrong Parkway to the south, and Beverly Drive to the north. Initial roadwork will include the replacement of damaged curbs, sidewalks, and the concrete pavement beneath the asphalt. Once the concrete repair work has been completed, the top 2-3 inches of the pavement will be removed and replaced with new asphalt.

The roadway work will take place in measured segments which will require temporary lane adjustments and lane closures. Cones, barricades, and signage will designate the construction zone. Although one lane each direction will remain open, motorists should plan ahead and select an alternate route to avoid traffic delays. Within the marked construction zone, the speed limit will be reduced from 30 M.P.H to 20 M.P.H. to increase safety for road crews and motorists. Construction hours will be between 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday. It is estimated the roadwork will require 90 days to complete.
