### **Town of Highland Park to Begin Roadway Project on Mockingbird Lane**

**June 17, 2016 (Highland Park, Texas)** – Beginning Monday, June 20, 2016, the Town of Highland Park will begin an intersection improvement project for the roadway, sidewalk, and signal lights at Mockingbird Lane and Abbott Avenue. It is anticipated that the project will be completed by August, 2016. The road construction will require lane adjustments for east and west bound traffic in the designated work zone. One block of Abbott Avenue, between Drexel Drive and Mockingbird Lane, will be closed throughout the duration of the project.

During the project, one lane east bound and one lane west bound on Mockingbird Lane will be closed to allow for roadway construction in the intersection. Signs and traffic markers will identify the lane adjustments around the work zone. It is recommended that motorists use alternative travel routes to avoid traffic congestion in the area. Pedestrians who normally cross Mockingbird Lane at Abbott Avenue are advised to use the crosswalk at Mockingbird Lane and Airline Road.
