### **Aggravated Robbery, 4800 Block of Lemmon Avenue**

**August 18, 2016 (Highland Park, Texas)** – At around 2:18 p.m. on Thursday, August 18, 2016, a female employee of TitleMax called 9-1-1 stating, “We were just robbed.” Officers were immediately dispatched to the TitleMax store, a business which is located in a strip shopping center in the 4800 block of Lemmon Avenue, and searched the area for the suspect.

Per the employee, the suspect entered the business through the front door, concealed part of his face with a bandana or scarf, then pointed a small handgun at her. The suspect demanded money from the employee, and also demanded money from a male customer who was inside the business. The suspect fled the business through the back door with an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency, then continued northbound or westbound on foot. Investigators have not ruled out the possibility of a getaway car parked nearby. No injuries were reported to investigating officers.

The suspect is described as a 25 – 30 year old black male, approximately 5’10 to 6’0 feet in height, trim build, wearing a grey, sun protection type hat (brim with fabric attached to the crown that covers the back of the neck), a grey or white long-sleeved shirt, and dark colored pants. Both the shirt and the pants were described as, “dirty.”
