

**TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK**  
**Application for Swimming Pool Season Permit**

PERMITS ARE ISSUED BY THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK TO THE BELOW LISTED PERMIT HOLDERS SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED ON THIS PERMIT.

1. The term of this permit is good for use of the Town's swimming pool per the dates and times established by the Town Council in the form of a Resolution for the current calendar year, and is valid only so long as the permit holder is a resident of the Town; and
2. It is understood that the Town assumes no liability for any damage or injury of the permit holder and/or his/her guest from use of the Town Swimming Pool; and
3. Each permit holder shall be responsible for any damage to the Town Swimming Pool; and
4. Permit is nontransferable, use by other than registered owner is unlawful; and
5. Each permit holder agrees to abide by the provisions of Town Ordinance No. 665, as amended.

PERMITS FOR ONE TO FOUR (1 - 4) FAMILY MEMBERS WILL BE SOLD AT \$60.00 EACH, ADDITIONAL FAMILY MEMBER PERMITS WILL BE SOLD AT \$30.00 EACH WHEN PURCHASED AT THE SAME TIME.

FAMILY IS DEFINED AS ANY NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS LIVING TOGETHER AS A SINGLE HOUSEKEEPING UNIT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND PARK IN WHICH NOT MORE THAN TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS ARE UNRELATED BY BLOOD, MARRIAGE OR ADOPTION, NEITHER OF WHICH UNRELATED INDIVIDUALS PAYS RENT TO ANY MEMBER OF THE FAMILY.
